SIX STEPS TO KEEP YOU COVERED

- 1 **Identify** relevant threats
- 2 **Evaluate** threats in relation to traveller profile
- 3 Set an acceptable **standard of risk** for organisation and traveller
- 4 Implement **mitigation strategies** that reduce threats to an acceptable risk level
- 5 **Monitor** for any change in threats or a breakdown in the mitigation strategy
- 6 **Respond quickly** to an incident when it occurs
